He will keep in touch with Jody and if he does see a problem, will attach the mower deck to Jody's mower and she has agreed to assist. Jane commented that the corner by Old Farm is looking good and asked about the town having a spring clean-up day this year. It was agreed to have the residential spring clean up day on May 16<sup>th</sup> in conjunction with the Medway Community Association and the Medway Fire Departments open house. David mentioned to Greg to revisit the policy on town owned equipment and to draft something for the board to review that he feels would be appropriate. Also a discussion as to extra power at the recreation complex. Terry McLaughlin is working up figures as to cost and the board asked that Jody incorporate this figure into her budget for the upcoming year. Board agreed to purchase a safe from Thornton Brothers in the amount of \$400.00. John Lee informed the board the Katahdin Paper had donated 40 chairs to the fire department to be used in conjunction with the senior citizens group.
